


MENTOR PROGRAM


Why all these words?

Because we are created by God to be in relationship with others. To one degree or another, each of these words describes friendship, and more specifically, a mentoring relationship. Now, we want to introduce the Royal Servants Mentor Program to you!




What does it mean to have a Royal Servants mentor?

It means you, the Royal Servant, have a one-on-one relationship with a person who is typically older and wiser (i.e. further along in their Christian journey) who provides consistent support, guidance, and prayer as you prepare for *and* return from your Royal Servants summer.




What should you expect in your mentoring relationship?

To meet two or three times before the trip *and* continue to meet after returning. The meetings will have a number of goals:

- The mentor will keep you accountable in support raising, helping you with the process, especially as procrastination is a temptation! Also, they will help with the Scripture memorization before the trip.
 - This relationship will also provide a safe place where you can share joys, frustrations, and prayers as you prepare for your Royal Servants trip - and also where the mentor can be a source of encouragement, accountability, wisdom, a listening ear, and pray for/with you for the trip and for your preparation for and return home.
 - **Note to the mentor** - You can expect to receive three letters, designed to give you insight into the mentoring relationship from a Royal Servants perspective. One will come shortly after the form on the back of this sheet is received; the other two will come in May and August.

Now what?

1. Think and pray about who you would like to have as a mentor.
 2. Contact that person soon, explaining the Royal Servants Mentor Program and expectations (showing them this letter), and asking them to be your mentor.
